Since 2016 he is assistant professor in the course of Architectural Design (LAP3) of the Department of Architecture of Ferrara, hold and coordinated by prof. Alessandro Massarente, furthermore contributing in the organization of workshops and study tours.

Actively involved in associationism and non-profit organizations he collaborates with cultural associations and with the City Council of Savignano sul Panaro in the definition of strategic proposals for local development.
